Let Us Discover

PROCEDURES OF BLOW-DRYING THE HAIR

1. Section the hair into four parts
2. Bring down a sub-section in the nape where you are to begin blow-drying. Blow-dry the hair under to create root lift.
3. After choosing the correct brush, start to blow-dry the hair upwards. Make sure that the air from the hairdryer flows through the hair in the correct direction.
4. Work your hair way up toward the crown. Make sure each section is completely dry and falls in the desired direction.
5. Take a section of hair at the sides and continue to blow-dry the hair so that it blends in with the back of the hair. Work your way toward the parting and repeat the same on the opposite side.
6. Move to the top and front sections of the half, continuously moving the hairdryer so that you will not cause discomfort to the client.

PRECAUTIONS

1. Ensure that all plugs are wired correctly.
2. Before you start drying, be sure to check the manufacturer's instructions for heat setting and speed control.
3. Check that the dryer cable and plug are always safe.
4. Every blower has an intake grill on the back which must be cleaned regularly to remove dust and lint. They may overheat and become dangerous if they are not cleaned.
5. Store electrical tools as required by the salon.

BLOW-DRY CAUTIONS

- Don't hold in one place too long.
- Direct airflow
- Direct hot air away from the scalp
- Move-in back-and-forth motion
- Use the cooling button to set the style
- Partially dry the hair before styling.
